TENDERFOOT

Scout/Tenderfoot:

The scout rank is earned by joining the Boy Scouts and demonstrating knowledge of Scouting ideals. The Tenderfoot Scout has just started to show some camping skills and basic knowledge of woodcraft.

SECOND CLASS

Second Class:

The badge is awarded when the Scout completes requirements in the areas of Scoutcraft, physical fitness, citizenship, personal growth and Scout Spirit.

FIRST CLASS

First Class:

Achievement of the rank of First Class is a major step: scouts who do so are more likely to retain Scout values as an adult and achieve the BSA primary mission of "producing useful citizens".

STAR

Star, Life, and Eagle ranks represent a second tier of ranks, where merit badges allow a scout to demonstrate more advanced skills and explore vocations. In addition to merit badges, the Star rank is the first where a major commitment to leadership roles in the troop is required.
